Where there is disagreement between the current ABC's and the new society rules, the new Society rules supersede the ABC's. For 'behaviour' issues, the New Society rules are now the law of the land. The exception to that is for the non-contact/contact transition which will be implemented on August 1, 2007. The populace will be notified if this date changes at any time. In order to get equipment up to speed, there is a three-month grace period (until December 1, 2006) for armour and weapon standards.

ToT Armoured Division Results

- Class 4, fighters with less than one year of tourney experience. There was quite the battle for this class with much of the year seeing ties between different fighters. Calendar Policy: Autocrats MUST submit *Date Reservation* and *Event Information* forms to Kalends (see officer listings) before an event is officially reserved or put on Calendar. Forms available from your Seneschal or the Kalends officer.On line forms which may be filled out electronically can be found on the Avacal webpage, under Officers/Seneschal/Forms.

All event copies for the Crier, Avantgarde, and Avacal Webpage have to go through the Calendar Officer. Make sure to note if you do not want the event copy in the Crier. The Avantgarde and webmasters do acccept longer/fancier versions of the event flyers but it still **must be sent through the Calendar**. Please have the event information form (with appropriate signatures) and event copy to the Calendar Officer by the 15th of the month, 2 months prior to the event. (i.e. If your event is January 22, have event copy in by November 15th).

Please include the following as required by the Crier:

- -Date of event (day and month and year)
- -Time of event (when site opens and closes)
- -Name of sponsoring group

-Location (name, street address, and town) of the site. The postal code should also be included if available. If there is no street address, this must be noted in the copy.

-Name (society and modern) and mail address of the autocrat; email address or phone number are discretionary but are very helpful. (I find it useful to include the feastocrat as well)

-If there is a fee for the event, the statement "make cheques payable to <Group>" must be included.

-Official SCA Event Title

-Modern Location (town/city)

The event copy can be a maximum of 300 words for branch or baronial events, 350 for Principality events.

Regional THUA Chancellors: Coordinate with teachers in your area to arrange classes for local events.

Arts & Sciences: The Principality Minister of Arts and Sciences is considered the chief artistic and scientific officer of the Coronet. You will have the responsibility of encouraging the research and development of historically accurate period art forms, technologies, and philosophies; promoting and encouraging period appropriate arts and sciences works and assisting in the selection of the Principality Arts and Sciences Champion. You will also be responsible for condensing the reports of your subordinate officers up to Kingdom Level.

Avacal Seneschal: The Seneschal is the legal representative of a branch. Seneschals sign all contracts, make sure that things are done pursuant to the restrictions of all modern laws, corpora and kingdom law, work with the chatelaines to handle all public relations, and normally conduct the business meetings/curia. The seneschals coordinate the branch officers.

What is a Seneschal?

The person - a seneschal is:

- someone who enjoys helping others
- willing to find out the answer to questions
- a listener to both the words and the meaning behind them
- someone who strives for a solution
- willing to take a stand for what is best for the group

The job - a seneschal must:

- oversee the daily functions of a group
- advise the Royalty
- be a formal and legal representative of SCA Inc
- look to long term development of a group
- collaborate with others to achieve

The team - a seneschal works with

- Royalty to develop a strong and proud group
- Curia to ensure the health and wellbeing of the group
- Seneschalate deputies and branches to strengthen each facet of the group

These are my personal opinions. There are documents that are available from An Tir and SCA Inc that can go into detail. Why do I present them to you? I will be stepping down from the position of Seneschale d'Avacal at February Investiture and Their Highnesses need to choose another. Please consider the position. There is work involved, yes, but there are many rewards as well. If you have questions, feel free to contact me at any time. If you would like to express an interest in the position, please submit a letter of intent and an outline of your goals to myself and Their Highnesses by November 1st (so that a successor may begin training at Coronet).

no chirurgeons in Myrgan Wood, none in Borealis, Vinjar, or anywhere else in Avacal.

We don't have enough Chirurgeons to bother with a Principality Chirurgeon. His Lordship Tvorimir Danilov is our Kingdom Chirurgeon and acting Principality Chirurgeon for Avacal. And he's mundanely in Renton, Washington!

I would love to see at least three chirurgeons in every shire and barony, but I can't put shillings in that many beer steins, so I am looking for volunteers.

If you have mundane first aid and CPR training, or higher certification, and would like to help make our game even safer than it is, I can offer three benefits.

First: as a warranted chirurgeon, you're recognized by the SCA as having a certain minimum level of training, and are familiar with SCA-specific injuries – in short, you're a known quantity.

Second: as a warranted chirurgeon, you'll have the benefit of an exchange of information on SCArelated first aid, a shared set of policies that will allow you to work effectively with people you haven't met before, and the organizational means to delegate and share the workload at an event. And many hands make light work.

Third: as a warranted officer of the SCA, you





may be covered by the SCA's liability insurance. The need for this is smaller here in Avacal than in the USA, and we won't dwell on the negative, but it can help if things go badly.

So, if you're trained in first aid and CPR and would like to help your Principality, your shire or barony and your SCA family and friends, please come and talk to me any time, or look for me on the Avacal Circus.

Many thanks to those of you who consider becoming a chirurgeon, and my profoundest thanks to the dozen or so people who have contacted me since Investiture; the chirurgeonate will be stronger and the fighters of Avacal safer for your generous offers.

Chirurgeons Wanted!!

Your Highnesses, Your Excellencies, Your Lordships and Ladyships, My Lords and Ladies, good gentles all:

My name is Geoffrey Kempe. Some of you will recognize me as a chirurgeon-in-training. I am here to explain the role of chirurgeons and the chirurgeonate and to clear up a couple of misunderstandings about first aid in the SCA.

The Chirurgeonate is the first-aid organization within the SCA. Its role is to provide first aid at SCA events. Members of the chirurgeonate provide first aid on a volunteer basis, and at no cost to the recipient.



And to answer the next favourite question: no, we do not practice period techniques. I do not carry leeches, except of the gummy variety; if you want to help me by grinding up rubies, I'm not interested in how you plan to apply them; and I will NOT taste your urine on a bet!

I will, however, provide the best modern first aid care I can to anyone who needs it.

Since anyone can carry and use a first aid kit, with or without training, you might wonder why the SCA bothers to organize its first aiders.





The Chirurgeonate exists for several reasons, most of which boil down to one word: team-work.

As an organized group, there is managerial control, discipline if, when and as needed, and there are uniform guidelines on how to handle combat injuries. The SCA can also compile injury statistics and evaluate the management of first aid at events. The benefit for the injured fighter is that a chirurgeon will have a clue on how to get you out of your armour or farthingale with minimal damage to equipment or clothing. And we won't treat you like a freak

in funny clothes. We also help mundane EMS responders as necessary, and can help explain how to deal with SCA-specific injuries.

So, why am I taking up valuable space in this newsletter? I'm recruiting, that's why! In all of Avacal, the Chirurgeonate has exactly TWO members. There's me in Sigelhundas, and there's Madieleen in Montengarde. There are (Continued on page 15)
